How can I recover a damaged video file downloaded from SmartyCam HD/GP HD?

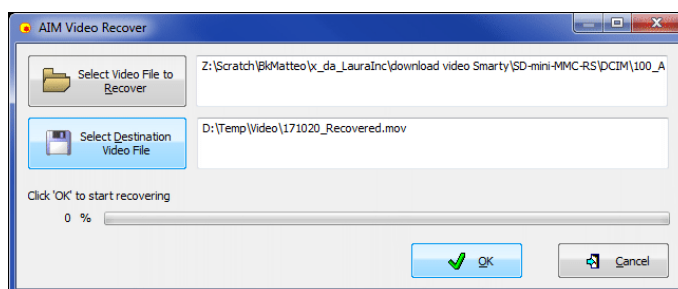
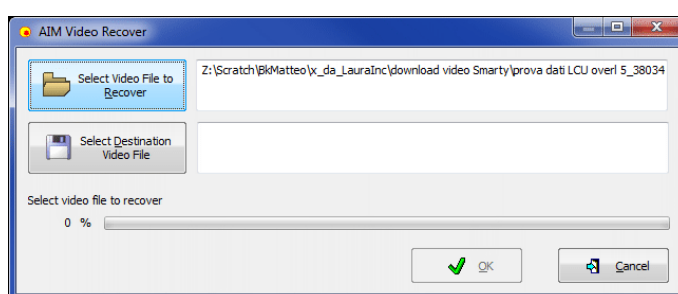
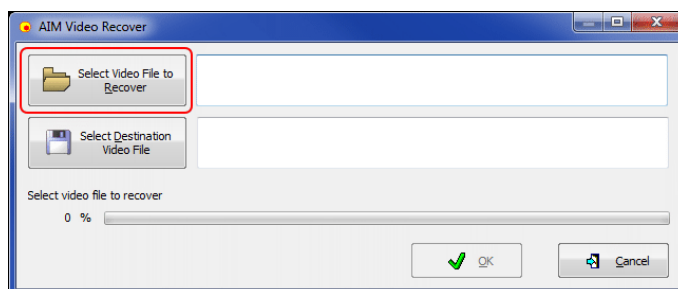
Answer:

A corrupted video file can be recovered using the FOF file, automatically generated by SmartyCam HD/GP HD and "AiM Video Recover" software. The tool can be downloaded at:

www.aim-sportline.com/aim-software-betas/Software/Applications/AiM_Video_Recover/AiMVideoRecover_installer.exe

Install the software and follow these instructions:

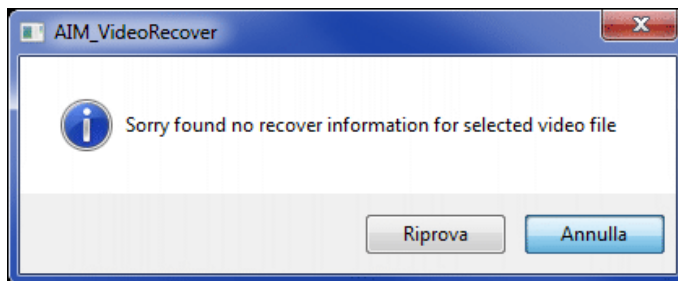
- run "AiM Video Recover"
- press "Select Video File to Recover"
- browse the PC and select the video to recover
- select the recovered file destination folder and fill in the recovered file name
- press "OK"



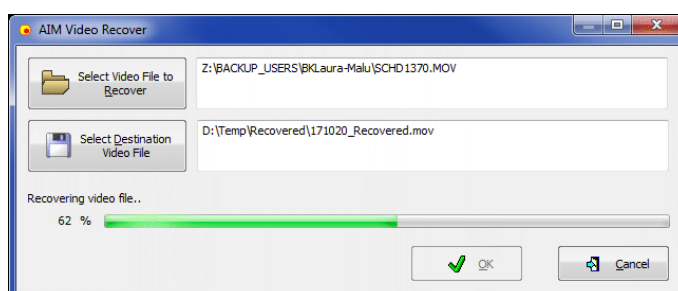


Video Recovery

- this operation can take several minutes
